**KEYPORT HARBOR**

<b>Reach A:</b> Commences approximately 1680 feet seaward of GREEN CAN #5 in Raritan Bay, to the first bend in the channel, located at approximately RED NUN #8 w/ LIGHT and approximately 50 feet seaward of GREEN CAN #7	File 86; Sheets 1&2 of 2; 19 March 2014	200	0.54	8	7.2	7.2	6.9
<b>Reach B:</b> Commences at the first bend in the channel, at approximately GREEN CAN #7 and RED NUN #8 w/ LIGHT, and continues to the end of the Keyport Harbor Channel, approximately 80 feet seaward of RED NUN #12	File 86; Sheet 2 of 2; 19 March 2014	200 – 100	0.32	8	5.2	5.7	5.2

**REMARKS:**

- All depths in Mean Lower Low Water (project originally authorized to Mean Low Water).
- Channel Length is in nautical miles

**KEYPORT HARBOR**

- **Reach A:** Shoaling begins in the Right Outside Quarter beginning approximately 175 feet landward of Green Can #5. Shoaling then extends across the width of the channel for the remainder of the reach beginning approximately 1000 feet landward of GREEN CAN #5 and continues to the end of the reach.
- **Reach B:** The entire reach is shoaled in.
