**Reach A:**

- There is no shoaling in this reach.

**Reach B:**

- Several small spot shoals exist in the vicinity of RED LIGHT #16 AND GREEN CAN #17. One of these spot shoals is in the Right Outside Quarter approximately 700 feet landward of RED LIGHT #16 and has a sounding of 10.0 feet below MLLW.
