## **NEWARK BAY**

- Reach A Main Channel South Reach: Shoaling exists along the channel's toe throughout portions of the Right Outside Quarter of this reach. Sporadic spot shoaling also exists in the Right Outside Quarter of this reach, within the parameters of approximately 360 feet landward of RED #4 W/LIGHT and approximately 1,120 feet landward of the same. Some spot shoaling exists in the Left Outside Quarter of this reach, within the parameters of approximately 850 feet landward of GREEN BUOY #7 W/LIGHT and approximately 1,660 feet landward of the same.
- Reach B Main Channel Middle Reach (South): Shoaling exists along the channel's toe in both the Left and Right
  Outside Quarters for much of this reach. Shoaling also extends across the width of the Left Outside Quarter and into
  the Left Inside Quarter beginning approximately 200 feet seaward of RED NUN #2 and continues landward to
  approximately 40 feet seaward of GREEN CAN #15A. Shoaling exists throughout much of the Right Outside Quarter of
  the channel, beginning approximately 725 feet seaward of RED #12 W/ LIGHT and continues landward to the end of
  this reach. Shoaling also exists in all four quarters of the channel for approximately the last 610 feet of this reach.
