CUT-OFF CHANNEL:

Reach A: Shoaling exists in the Right Outside and Inside Quarters of the channel from approximately 25 feet landward of the beginning of the channel to approximately 115 feet landward of GREEN CAN #5 FLOOD, with a maximum width of approximately 500 feet. Spot shoaling exists in the Left Outside and Inside Quarters of the channel approximately 80 feet landward of the beginning of the channel until approximately 385 feet landward of the same. Edge shoaling exists in the Left Outside Quarter of the channel from the approximate vicinity of RED BEACON #8 until approximately 130 feet landward of MOORING BUOY FLOOD, with a maximum width of approximately 95 feet.
