## Issue:

- Habitats in the FIMP area have been altered over the past century by man-made activities.

## Challenge:

- To improve significant habitats and protect human life and property from storm damage by restoring natural processes.

## Meeting the challenge:

The five processes targeted for restoration:

- Alongshore sediment transport.
- Cross-shore sediment transport.
- Dune growth and evolution.
- Bayside shoreline processes.
- Circulation and water quality.



Use the Habitat Evaluation Procedure (HEP) to assess habitats and species usage within the FIMP area. Recommendations may include:

- Changes to management measures.
- Modifications of existing structures.
- Interventions that mimic natural processes.
