



# Managing Inlets


- Inlets provide for safe navigation.
- Inlets allow storm surge to enter the bay.
- Inlets interrupt natural, alongshore sediment movement when jetties extend into the path of the sand.
- Inlet management measures proposed include sand bypassing: to dredge sand from ebb shoal (accumulation of sand at seaward mouth of tidal inlet) and authorized navigation channels to place on downdrift shorelines to mimic or compensate for interrupted littoral drift.
- These practices are subject to change over time if monitoring suggests different approaches are warranted.
