U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Draft Feasibility Report and Environmental Impact Statement for Mamaroneck & Sheldrake Rivers Basin Flood Risk Management General Reevaluation Report now available

Comment period extended, comment period closes March 30, 2016

NEW YORK – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New York District, in partnership with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), announces the release of the Draft General Reevaluation Report for the Mamaroneck and Sheldrake Rivers Basin in the Village of Mamaroneck, Westchester County, NY, Flood Risk Management Study and Environmental Impact Statement.

In accordance with the Water Resource Development Act of 1986 section 401(a) (PL 99-662), the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has the authority to complete ongoing feasibility studies and projects in the Northeast, including the Village of Mamaroneck. This Draft Environmental Impact Statement was prepared to evaluate the significance of potential environmental impacts of the proposed action.
