

Dear Mr. Brickman:

This letter is to seek the assistance of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers under Section 14 of the 1946 Flood Control Act, as amended, in reducing the threat of damages along the Bronx River in the vicinity of Yonkers Avenue, Village of Tuckahoe, NY.

The Village owns the road along Yonkers Avenue, which covers vital public infrastructure in the nature of a sewer line. In addition, two utility poles are built into the road parallel to the river. Flooding and storm damage has impacted Yonkers Avenue, with the road showing signs of sinking, cracking, and settlement, especially where the road is adjacent to the Bronx River. Yonkers Avenue is the only emergency route from Tuckahoe to the City of Yonkers. Its erosion threatens public safety as well as the public infrastructure.

We understand that we would be required to pay at least 35 percent of the total cost of a project, with credit granted toward this amount for providing lands, easements and rights-of-way, and that the minimum cash requirement from us would be 5 percent of the total project cost. We are able and willing to proceed to construction within a year, if a feasible project is found.
