POSTPONEMENT OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

To Whom It May Concern:


On October 2, 2013, the New York District Corps of Engineers issued Public Notice Number NAN-2009-01089-EYA describing an application for Department of the Army authorization submitted by Champlain Hudson Power Express, Inc. to construct a 332.8 mile long high voltage direct current electric transmission system between Canada and Queens, New York.

As the lead agency, the US Department of Energy will hold public hearings on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Champlain Hudson Power Express, Inc. Project. This supplemental Public Notice is being issued as notification that due to the lapse in appropriations resulting in the current Federal government shutdown, the lead Federal Agency for this project, the US Department of Energy has postponed the public hearings previously scheduled for this project as announced in the Public Notice from this office issued on October 2, 2013.

Further information on the rescheduled dates and locations of the Public Hearings will be announced by USDOE and by this office through an additional Supplemental Public Notice when Federal Appropriations become available.
