On October 17, 2019, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) issued Supplemental Public Notice Number NAN-2016-00908-A-EHA concerning a proposal by Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company to add to their existing permit application ocean placement of the approximately 735,000 cubic yards of dredged material from the excavation / dredging of the trench for the burial of their proposed Northeast Supply Enhancement Project pipeline below the waters of Raritan Bay and Lower New York Bay and the Atlantic Ocean.

The comment period deadline has been extended to January 17, 2020. Therefore, the USACE, New York District, is issuing this Supplemental Public Notice to inform interested persons of the extended comment deadline.
