**SUPPLEMENT PUBLIC NOTICE FOR
MAINTENANCE DREDGING OF THE MAIN, PORT NEWARK, AND PORT
ELIZABETH REACHES OF THE NEWARK BAY, NEW JERSEY,
FEDERAL NAVIGATION CHANNEL**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

By Public Notice No. Newark Bay 06 (copy attached), dated May 2, 2005, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New York District announced the maintenance dredging of Port Newark and Port Elizabeth reaches of the Newark Bay, New Jersey, with subsequent placement of the dredged material at a suitable, permitted placement site(s).

The previous cycle of maintenance dredging was completed in March 2007. Due to the limited of funds, only 196,360 cubic yards of sediment was removed from the Port Newark and Port Newark Pierhead Channels.

By this public notice supplement, the New York District proposes to undertake maintenance dredging of the select shoals that remain in the Port Newark and Port Elizabeth reaches which were left over from the previous dredging cycle due to lack of funds. In addition, the District proposes maintenance dredging of select critical shoals located in a portion of the Main Channel reach (see attached map). For the upcoming 2008 maintenance dredging cycle, it is anticipated that approximately 100,000 to 200,000 cubic yards of material will be dredged (depending on the amount of funds available for the 2008 dredging cycle). The dredged material will be disposed of at a suitable, permitted upland placement site(s) furnished by the contractor.

The proposed maintenance dredging of Newark Bay will be coordinated with the State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for their review under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act and Section 307(c) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended (16 U.S.C. 1456(c)). State Water Quality Certification and determination of consistency with the State Coastal Zone Management Policies will be obtained before any work proceeds.

It is requested that you communicate the foregoing information concerning the proposed work to any persons known by you to be interested and who did not receive a copy of this notice.
