This public notice announces the relocation of the New York District's Upstate Regulatory Field Office (URFO) to a new location. Effective **Monday, October 15, 2007**, the Upstate Regulatory Field Office will be located on the U.S. Army's Watervliet Arsenal in Watervliet, New York, just a few miles south of their former location at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers New York District's Albany Field Office, Federal Troy Lock and Dam, 1 Bond Street, Troy, New York

**New Visitor Procedures:** Because the Upstate Regulatory Field Office is located on a U.S. Army installation, advance notice of a visit is required for entrance onto the Watervliet Arsenal. Please contact the Permits Processing Team or the Permits Compliance and Enforcement Team at the telephone numbers above, as appropriate, to make an appointment prior to your visit. All visitors must provide in advance their names, company/agency affiliation, date/time of requested visit, contact telephone number, and a brief description of the purpose of the visit. Photo identification for each visitor will be required at the Watervliet Arsenal entrance gate. Hand deliveries to the new Upstate Regulatory Field Office must have a prior approved appointment. The new office location will be at **Watervliet Arsenal, Building 10, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.**

Alcohol, illegal drugs, and any weapons or explosives are prohibited on the installation, including in vehicles entering the installation. Cameras must be approved in advance, in writing, by the Watervliet Arsenal Security Office prior to being brought on to and/or used on the installation.
