Army Corps announces remaining three public information sessions regarding Fire Island to Montauk Point Reformulation Study

NEW YORK – The Army Corps of Engineers, New York District, is announcing the dates for the remaining three public information sessions regarding the Army Corps of Engineers' ongoing Fire Island to Montauk Point (FIMP) Reformulation Study. The meetings will be held in Patchogue, Southampton and Montauk. The purpose of the ongoing FIMP Reformulation Study is to identify, evaluate and recommend long-term solutions for hurricane and storm damage reduction for homes and businesses within the floodplain extending along 83-miles of ocean and bay shorelines from Fire Island Inlet to Montauk Point.

There will be informational displays and New York District staff will be available to discuss the study. The meeting is meant to be an opportunity for the public to learn more about the potential solutions being considered in the study and to discuss them. The public will also be able to leave written comments/suggestions. As the ongoing work is a collaboration with several partners, representatives from New York State, the Department of the Interior and local communities are expected to attend the sessions.
