Notice of Availability

**Section 111 Mitigation of Erosion Damages
Due to the Federal Navigation Project at Mattituck Harbor, New York**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New York District (District) announces the availability of the Draft Detailed Project Report and Environmental Assessment (DPR/EA) for the Section 111 Mitigation of Erosion Damages Due to the Federal Navigation Project at Mattituck Harbor, New York.

The tentatively selected mitigation plan initially calls for dredging approximately 90,000 cubic yards of littoral (sandy) material from the vicinity of the Mattituck Inlet jetties, and 10,000 cubic yards from the accumulated littoral material at Breakwater Beach located just west of the inlet. The material would be bypassed to and spread along the eroded shores to the east (downdrift) of the inlet over a distance of about 4500 feet. The bypassed material would form a beach berm that would be approximately 20 feet wide at elevation +8 feet. The beach would slope seaward effectively forming a beach area about 100 feet wide from the base of the bluffs to mean sea level. The environmental impacts of the project are not expected to be significant. Details of the tentatively selected plan will be discussed at the public meeting.
