Corps to commence work at last vicinity property adjacent to the former NL site

NEW YORK -- The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, New York District, is scheduled to begin the cleanup of contaminated soil on the CSX property along the southern boundary of the former National Lead site. The clean up and backfilling of this last remaining vicinity property is expected to be completed this fall. The land is adjacent to the former NL site, which is being cleaned up as part of the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program.

James T. Moore, project manager for the Corps, said a public meeting is being planned for Oct. 18 to update the community on the progress at the site. Meeting details will be announced as soon as they are confirmed.
