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Corps seeks bids for MOTBY building demolition

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New York District, is seeking bids for the demolition of seven buildings on the former Military Ocean Terminal, Bayonne.

The procurement is restricted to eligible 8(a) participants, as classified by the Small Business Administration, and located in SBA's New York Region II or New Jersey.

The estimated construction cost of the project is \$5 million to \$10 million. The Corps is seeking a firm-fixed price contract for demolition, removal, and disposal of the seven buildings, which range in size from 9,600 square feet to 120,000 square feet. Each building is to be razed level to its existing on-grade concrete floor.

Work on the demolition is expected to begin in the fall of this year. Plans and specifications for the contract, designated contract DACA51-00-B-0023, are expected to be available on or about Aug. 8 and contract award made on or about Sept. 8. Required Central Contractor Registration, in accordance with Defense Finance and Accounting Regulations (252.203-7004) applies to this procurement.
