U.S. Army Corps of Engineers schedules additional public hearing session on St. Lawrence Cement Co. application

New York – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers New York District announced today that it will conduct two days of public hearings on the St. Lawrence Cement Company's request to improve an existing marine terminal serving its cement manufacturing facilities.

The initial volume of responses from the public on this application prompted the Corps of Engineers to schedule an additional public hearing session in order to accommodate the high level of public interest.

Public Hearings will be held at the Columbia Greene Community College (Theatre in Arts Center auditorium), Route 23, Hudson, NY, March 18-19, in three sessions:

March 18, 2003

Session 1: 1 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Session 2: 6 p.m. to 11 p.m. (Note: May conclude earlier if all parties desiring to comment have done so prior to 11 p.m.)

March 19, 2003

Session 3: 1 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

In order to facilitate public comment, the Corps of Engineers has made available a number of options for individuals to provide comments.

Those desiring to make a public oral statement can do so in the auditorium or they can tape their statement in an adjacent room.

In addition, written comments may be mailed to reach the Corps of Engineers not later than April 1, 2003. Comments are also being accepted via e-mail, and should include the sender's name and address and be sent to Saint.L.Cement@usace.army.mil
