Tuckahoe Rocket Range Site, Corbin, NJ

DESCRIPTION:

The site was located in the village of Tuckahoe, Township of Upper, Cape May County, New Jersey. The Department of the Navy utilized 1,800 acres of Lester G. McNamara Fish and Wildlife Management Area. The sites were used by the Navy as an aerial rocket range. In 1948, the Navy terminated its permit with the State of New Jersey. The State of New Jersey, Department of Environmental Protection Division of Fish and Wildlife is still the current owner of the Former Tuckahoe Rocket Range.

AUTHORIZATION/PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The former Tuckahoe Rocket Range Site is shown on the Township of Upper Tax Map (No. 16) as Block 348, Lot 95. The Tuckahoe Rocket Range Site is being investigated under the Defense Environmental Restoration Program for Formerly Used Defense Sites. The Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 authorized that program.

STATUS:.....

Corps has performed a site investigation of former Tuckahoe Rocket Range site and completed a second Technical Project Planning (TPP) Meeting in September 2007. Based on the results of field work, a remedial investigation has been recommended for this site.
