Mount Kisco, New York
Section 205, Flood Control

FACT SHEET

DESCRIPTION: Branch Brook is located in Mount Kisco in northwestern Westchester County. Branch Brook is a tributary to the Kisco River (which originates in the Town of Bedford, flows northward to Howlands Lake, turns west through Mount Kisco, and flows northward through the Town of New Castle into New Croton Reservoir). Branch Brook originates in the Town of Bedford and flows southward into Mount Kisco and the Kisco River. The flat slope of Branch Brook, together with high stages on the Kisco River, and insufficient bridge crossing areas cause periodic flooding. The flooding affects the central business district of Mount Kisco as often as once or twice a year.

AUTHORIZATION: The study of Branch Brook is authorized by Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948 (PL 80-858), as amended.

STATUS: An initial Appraisal Report has been completed and Federal interest has been identified. No potential non-Federal sponsor has expressed interest to date.
