FACT SHEET

DESCRIPTION: Brentwood Brook is located in southeastern Westchester County within the Town of Harrison. Brentwood Brook is the largest tributary to Beaver Swamp Brook, which drains into Mamaroneck Harbor and Long Island Sound. Flooding occurs along a 6,000-foot stretch of Brentwood Brook both upstream and downstream of the New England Thruway. During the 1972 storm, approximately 75 homes were flooded. A recurrence of the June 1972 storm would damage more than 100 homes, many of which would be flooded above the main floor.

AUTHORIZATION: The study of Brentwood Brook is authorized by Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948 (PL 80-858), as amended.

STATUS: With the funds added by Congress in FY 2002, an Initial Appraisal report was initiated and will be completed by Fall 2004.
