FACT SHEET

DESCRIPTION: The project area is located in southeastern Westchester County within the Town of Harrison, New York. The pond occupies approximately 0.9 acre and is presently of low biological value. The goal of this project is to restore and protect the natural ecosystem structure, function, and processes, and transform the site into a less degraded, more natural state that would be more in the public interest and to have it done in a manner that minimizes cost, maximizes benefits, is environmentally acceptable, and complies with guidance, procedure, policy, and law.

AUTHORIZATION: Section 206, Water Resources Development Act of 1996, as amended

STATUS: A Preliminary Restoration Plan (PRP) has been completed. No Federal interest is found.
