Streambank Erosion Protection

FACT SHEET

DESCRIPTION: Stream bank erosion on both banks of the Bronx River stretches for approximately 100 feet downstream of the Harney Road bridge, threatening to undermine the Bronx River Parkway. In the absence of action, a major road will be undermined by the Bronx River, threatening a property of historic significance, disrupting regional commerce and government business causing potential harm to the drivers and pedestrians using the Parkway.

AUTHORIZATION: Section 14 of the 1946 Flood Control Act of 1946, as amended [33 U.S.C. 701(r)].

STATUS: An Initial Appraisal Report (IAR) has been drafted and identifies Federal interest in protecting the Bronx River Parkway. The prospective sponsor is the Westchester County Department of Planning. The next step, pending approval of the IAR and receipt of funds, is the initiation of the Planning Design and Analysis (PDA) phase, which consists of all planning and design and environmental compliance activities to demonstrate that Federal participation is warranted.
