Flood Damage Reduction Study

FACT SHEET

DESCRIPTION: The Larchmont Reservoir is part of a system of ponds located along the Sheldrake River in Westchester County, New York. During periods of heavy rain and runoff, the reservoir serves as a detention pond to prevent extensive flooding in the downstream communities of New Rochelle and Mamaroneck. Local communities are concerned that recent sedimentation of this reservoir has severely degraded the capacity and flood damage reduction potential of the reservoir.

AUTHORIZATION/PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948, as amended.

STATUS: The Initial Appraisal Report (IAR) has been initiated, and the current flood conditions and the potential for Federal interest in this study will be documented in the IAR scheduled to be completed by the Summer of 2003.
