### Ecosystem Restoration Project

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#### FACT SHEET

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**DESCRIPTION:** A productive salt marsh was lost in 1963 when dredge material from Northport Harbor was placed on the site located in Northport Harbor at the southern terminus of the water edge to approximately 250 ft. north of Route 25 A (Northern Blvd.). The plan is to remove the dredge material and create an estuarine pond including a salt marsh fringe in the Betty Allen Preserve.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Section 1135 (b) of WRDA 1986, as amended

**STATUS:** A feasibility study is currently underway. Site surveys, design efforts and environmental assessments are being completed as necessary documentation for the Environmental Restoration Report. The draft report will be completed in 2004.
