Ecosystem Restoration Study

FACT SHEET

DESCRIPTION: The project is located in the Town of Mamaroneck and City of New Rochelle on the Sheldrake River. Both Sheldrake Lake and Goodliffe Pond are considered important environmental resources providing educational as well as recreational benefits. According to the Town of Mamaroneck, there are sedimentation problems with the two ponds, which resulted in habitat degradation, water quality impairments, and increased flooding.

AUTHORIZATION: Section 206, Water Resources Development Act of 1996, as amended {33 U.S.C. 2330}.

STATUS: A Preliminary Restoration Plan (PRP) was completed and is being coordinated with potential non-Federal sponsors. A Project Management Plan (PMP) is being developed and a feasibility study will be initiated in FY04. In FY03, the Mamaroneck Reservoir study was combined with this effort. The project is postponed for the rest of FY2004 due to programmatic constraints on Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration (Section 206) projects.
