Streambank Erosion Protection

FACT SHEET

DESCRIPTION: The project site is located in the vicinity of the Westchester County Center complex, near the intersection of the Bronx River Parkway and Central Avenue. Streambank erosion on the Bronx River stretches for approximately 1600 feet south downstream of the Central Avenue Bridge and continues north of the bridge for at least a few hundred feet, threatening to the undermine the Bronx River Parkway. In addition, the Central Avenue bridge abutments are also being threatened by erosion.

AUTHORIZATION: Section 14 of the 1946 Flood Control Act of 1946, as amended [33 U.S.C. 701(r)].

STATUS: An Initial Appraisal Report (IAR) has been drafted and identifies Federal interest in protecting the Bronx River Parkway and the Central Avenue bridge. The prospective sponsor is the Westchester County Department of Planning. The next step, pending approval of the IAR and receipt of funds, is the initiation of the Planning Design and Analysis (PDA) phase, which consists of all planning and design and environmental compliance activities to demonstrate that Federal participation is warranted.
