Repairs to Breakwater

FACT SHEET

DESCRIPTION: Rebuild/repair head segment of rock breakwater.

AUTHORIZATION: Existing project (adapted 1887) provides for a breakwater, 800 feet long extending from the shore to the 16 feet contour of Lake Champlain.

STATUS: Funds for construction were not included in the FY 05 through FY 08 budgets. Work has been deferred indefinitely until funds are made available.

OUTSTANDING ISSUES: Work required includes performing E&D, preparing Plans and Specifications (P&S) and performing construction activities for the repair of breakwater head segment. Breakwater protects Ferry Landing from wave action and ice flows.

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
