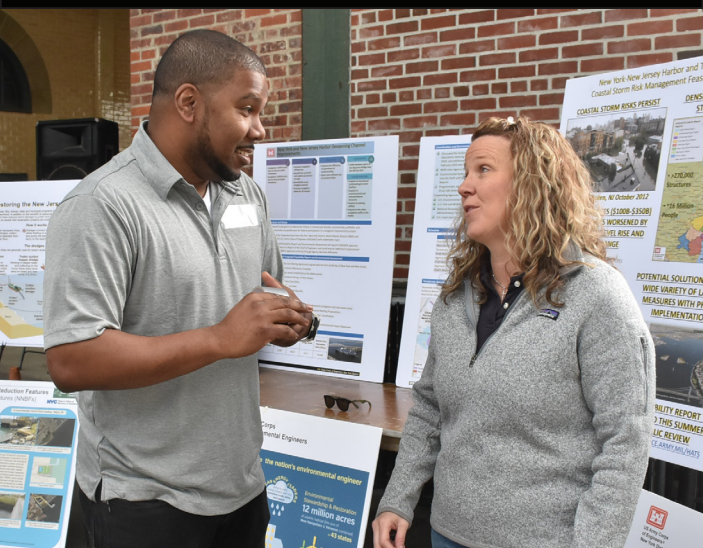

1 Civil Works

- > Building structures to keep communities safe from floods, storms + rising seas.
