**REMARKS:**

- Depths are relative to Mean Lower Low Water (MLLW) datum.
- Channel reach lengths are in nautical miles.

**Ward Point Bend:**

- **Reach T:** Shoaling exists in the Left Outside Quarter approximately 140 feet landward of GREEN CAN #1 EBB and continues landward, extending across the full width of the Reach at the approximate locations of RED NUN #4 EBB and GREEN CAN #3 EBB, before ending approximately 750 feet landward of RED NUN #6 EBB. Shoaling exists in the Right Outside Quarter approximately 220 feet landward of GREEN CAN #1 EBB and continues approximately 650 feet landward with a maximum width of approximately 75 feet.
