Reach A (Sole Reach): From junction with the Raritan River Channel in the vicinity RED/GREEN JUNCTION 'R' W/LIGHT EBB; to the junction with the New York & New Jersey Channel approximately 2,300 feet landward of RED NUN #2 EBB. REMARKS:

- All depths are in Mean Lower Low Water (MLLW) datum.
- Channel reach length is in nautical miles.
- For the purposes of this report, seaward is oriented toward the Raritan River and landward is toward the Arthur Kill.

CUT-OFF CHANNEL:

Reach A: Majority of shoaling exists in the beginning half of this reach, throughout all four quarters to approximately 810 feet landward of RED NUN #6 EBB, then continuing to taper into both the Left and Right Outside Quarters. The controlling depth of -14.7 feet MLLW exists in the Left Outside Quarter at approximately 395 feet landward of RED NUN #6 EBB.
