- Major shoaling exists across the entire channel starting approximately 1900 feet landward from the start of the reach and extends approximately 2480 feet landward. There are several areas of shoaling across and in the center along the remaining landward portion of the reach.
- The controlling depth of +7.1 feet MLLW exists in Left Inside Quarter at approximately 2,880 feet landward from GREEN CAN #3 W/LIGHT FLOOD.
