Dear Mr. Madara:

This letter is in reference to the Peckman River Basin Flood Risk Management Feasibility Study in New Jersey. The US Army Corps of Engineers has identified Alternative 10b-40 as the optimized Tentatively Selected Plan (TSP). This plan consists of a diversion culvert connecting the Peckman and Passaic Rivers; associated weirs; levees and floodwalls; and channel modifications which provide flood risk management to the Borough of Woodland Park. The plan also includes nonstructural measures within the ten percent floodplain upstream of Route 46 to provide flood risk management to the Township of Little Falls. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) supports the identification of Alternative 10b-40 as the optimized Tentatively Selected Plan (TSP) and the recommendation within the upcoming Final Integrated Feasibility Report & Environmental Assessment (FIFR/EA) report that this plan be developed further within the current Feasibility Phase and ultimately recommended for design and implementation.


