**ARMY CORPS AWARDED
ORDNANCE REMOVAL CONTRACT
FOR THE
FORMER RARITAN ARSENAL (FUDS)**

NEW YORK -- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers New York District awarded a contract to accomplish ordnance removal at Area 12 of the Former Raritan Arsenal FUDS. This Task Order, which contains Firm-Fixed-Price and Fixed-Unit-Price Tasks, was issued to USA Environmental Incorporated to perform a Subsurface Sampling and Ordnance clearance in Dense Anomaly Portions of Area 12.

The original contract was awarded March 31, 2009 to USA Environmental, Inc. of Oldsmar, FL in the amount of \$1,283,842.80 to clear 3.2 acres. Effective March 18, 2010, a modification to the contract increased the total awarded amount to \$3,788,797.72 to clear (3.2 +7.18) a total of 10.38 acres of Area 12.

- Dense anomalies = 24 acres
- Previously cleared = 1.5 acres (accomplished by different contractor)
- Underway (funded) = 10.38 acres
- Remaining (unfunded) = 12.12 acres (estimated \$4.2 million)

OBJECTIVE: USA Environmental is tasked to perform the following:

- 1) Perform statistically reliable sampling to more precisely define the horizontal extent of ordnance distribution in the dense anomaly locations and
- 2) Provide all Munitions Response (MR) services necessary to remove Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC), Material Potentially Presenting an Explosive Hazard (MPPEH) and all other ferrous materials, to include munitions debris from the Former Raritan Arsenal, Area 12.

TIMEFRAME: Ordnance removal funded to date will be completed by December 2010. USA Environmental mobilized on 25 April 2010. By December 2010, 10.38 acres will be cleared of ordnance.

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
